Realizing Our Community Vision of a College Prep High School



Our new secondary campus will be located at 1039 Garden Street, less than half a block from EPACS – we are realizing our vision of a seamless K-12 educational community.

East Palo Alto Phoenix Academy (or, affectionately “EPAPA”) is a college prep charter high school dedicated to preparing 100% of our students for success in college and beyond. Our school grew out of East Palo Alto Charter School (“EPACS”), a high-performing K-8 charter school that was founded by parents in 1997. In 2006, EPACS parents demanded that we expand to include the high school years, and since then, our high school has been housed in a series of make-shift classrooms and a converted warehouse.

*In March 2011 we broke ground on a new secondary campus. Our community is benefiting from a unique public-private partnership that will allow us to move into a brand new building right near our elementary feeder school. The new facility is being funded by generous grants from Sequoia Union High School District, the Charles and Helen Schwab Foundation, and a facilities bond issued by our own organization, Aspire Public Schools. And while we couldn't be more appreciative of the contributions made on behalf of our students, the \$13 million contributed by our partners will only cover the cost of constructing the building. **The EPAPA Move-in Campaign will help us fully realize our vision by providing for the materials and resources that characterize a high-performing college prep high school.***
