SFUSD Measure A Bond Projects, *San Francisco, CA*

Principal-in-Charge for several modernization projects totaling over \$40 million. The projects focus on ADA Accessibility & Fire Life Safety upgrades and include: Aptos Middle School, Downtown High School, Spring Valley Elementary, Burnett Child Development Center, and Francis Scott Key Elementary.

Willie L. Brown, Jr. Middle School, *San Francisco, CA*

Principal in Charge and Designer for a new \$44.6 million, 88,000 sf middle school for SFUSD. Created through a highly collaborative community-focused design process, the new, three-building campus includes a wellness center and fitness facility to serve the community. CCSF Community Wellness Center, *San Francisco, CA*

Principal-in-Charge for a new \$71 million, 156,000 sf academic athletic facility that includes a gymnasium, aquatics center, martial arts, yoga, aerobics studio, team and PE locker rooms, weight rooms, dance performance facility and faculty offices. This project is designed as a LEED® equivalent facility.

CCSF Student Health Center & Classroom Building, *San Francisco, CA*

Principal-in-Charge for a \$9.5 million new 22,000 sf modern health care and classroom facility. A 2-story steel framed building, the first floor program is a comprehensive health clinic and counseling center. The second floor program includes 10 new interdisciplinary classrooms.
